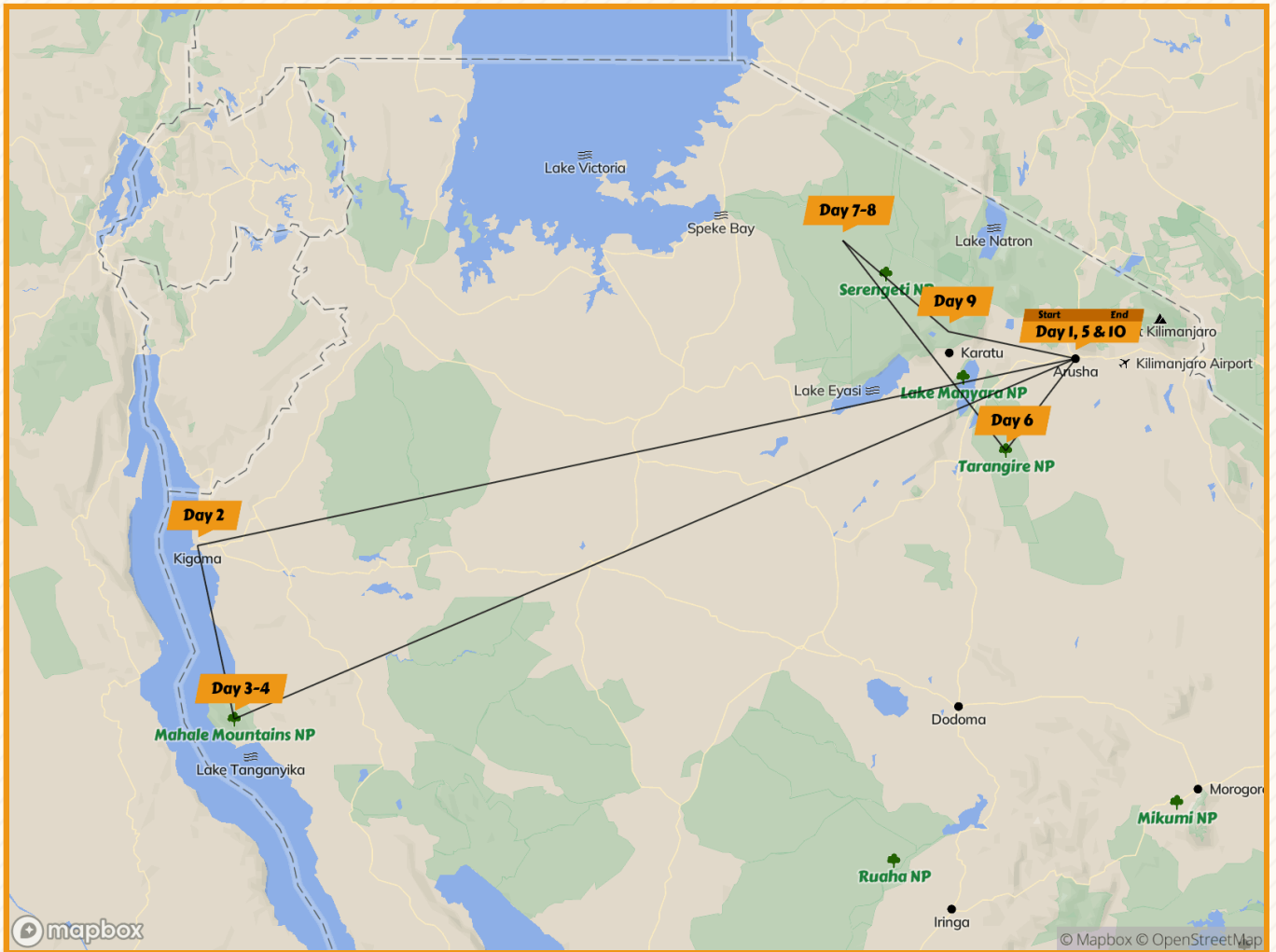

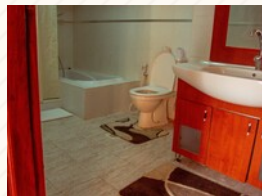

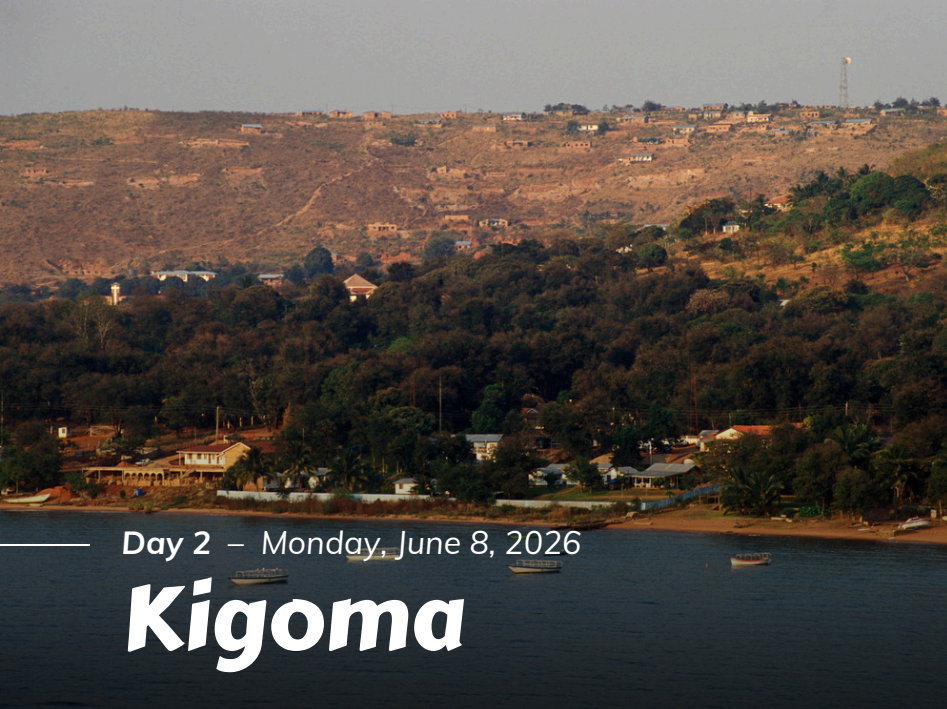

Immerse yourself in the rainforest and share the experience with chimpanzees – Mahale Mountains has more than 900 chimps, many of them used to humans. The time you spend with them is an all-time safari favorite for many visitors. On your way to find the chimps, look for blue duikers, red-tailed monkeys and red colobus monkeys. Remain on the lookout in case a giant pangolin or a leopard decides to show itself. Or listen to the birds – there are many colorful forest species here that you can see nowhere else in East Africa. And don't forget glorious Lake Tanganyika, with its white-sand beaches, hippos, crocodiles and otters.

Chimp Trekking, Mahale Mountains National Park

Trek with us into the forests of Mahale Mountains National Park where they've been studying chimps since 1965. We'll help you find them, and because they've been studied so long, the chimps let you get nice and close. You'll get to spend an hour with them, and only small groups are allowed during that time. It's an intimate experience.
